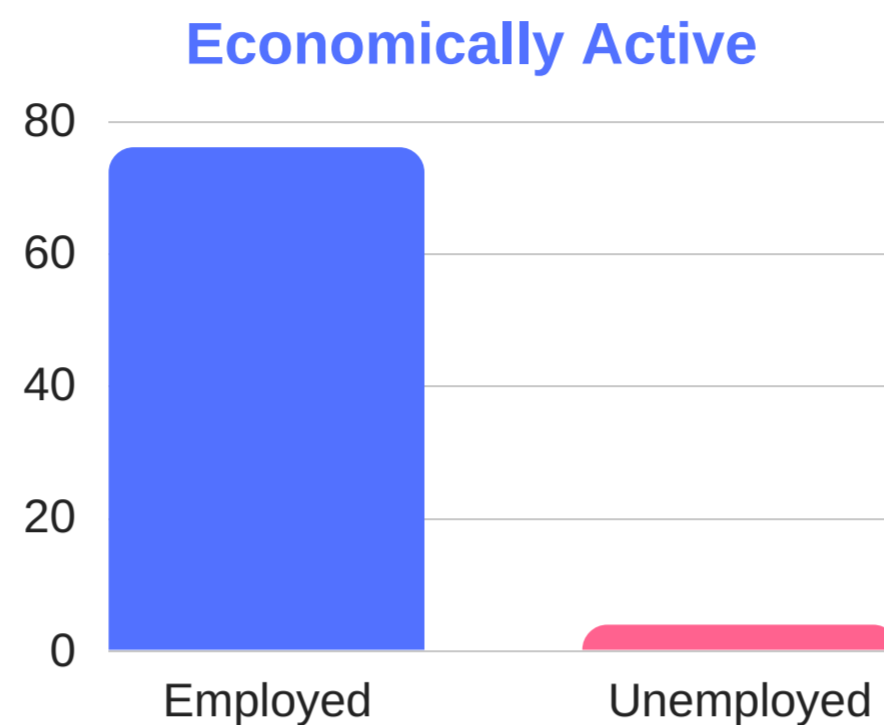


Employment

The average income is **£28,901** a year

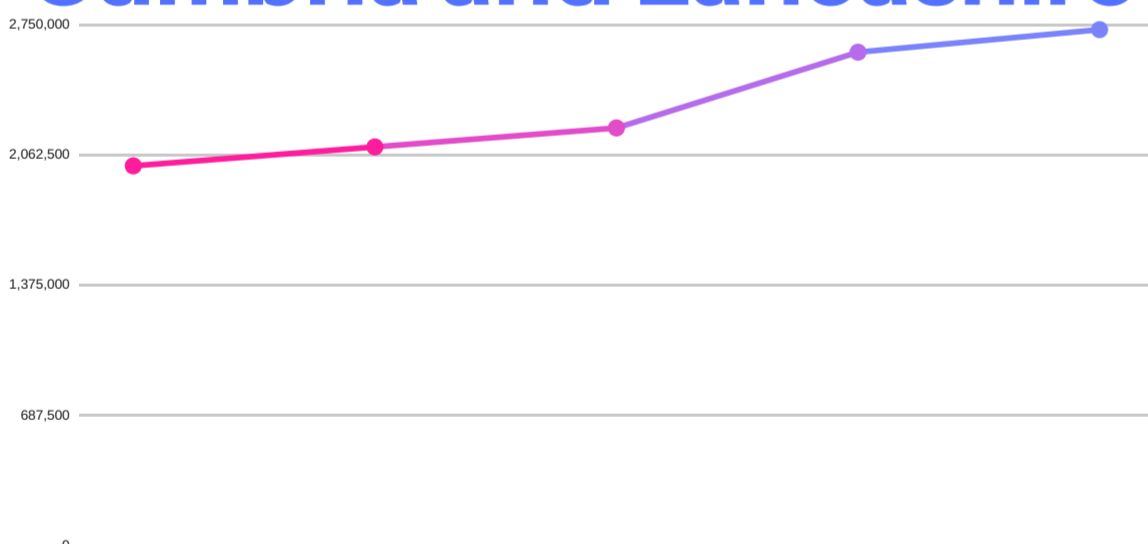


On average people in the Liverpool, Cumbria and Lancashire work **30.7** hours a week
